Summary of Course Requirements

+39 credit hours required for graduation (core courses listed above)

+PubPol 800 (Career Practicum) and PubPol 890-1 (Excel Foundations) are required in the first semester. These courses are not graded and carry no credit hours

+ PUBPOL 816 (Ethics and Policy Making) or PUBPOL 890 (Organizational Ethics or other MPP Ethics course) is required for graduation

* Students who place out of 810 (Microeconomics & Policy Making) will enroll in 811 (Microeconomics & Policy Applications) in fall semester and will take an elective in place of 811 in the spring semester

** Students who place out of 812 (Statistics & Data Analysis) will enroll in 813 (Advanced Statistics) in the fall semester and will take an elective in place of 813 in the spring semester

Policy Concentration Requirements
